Introduction: The second layer of our five fold foundation, upon which we build our Christian world view, is the foundation of Jehovah God. Dr. Harold Willington, Chancellor of the Liberty University Bible Institute, wrote in His book *The Doctrine of the Trinity*, page 11 "*The greatest and most profound idea the human mind can ever conceivably entertain concerns the possibility of the existence of a personal God. The sheer importance of man's response to this idea cannot be exaggerated, for it will not only govern his life down here but will also determine his ultimate destiny. Unless one satisfactorily answers the 'who' question, he cannot possibly solve the 'how, why, when, and where' problems of his own existence.*" Dr. Mark Cambron, when speaking about Jehovah in his book *Bible Doctrines*, page 33 says "*The world is a bud from His bower of beauty. The sun is a spark from the light of His wisdom. The sky is a bubble on the sea of His power.*" We must conclude, with these two tremendous Biblical scholars, that Jehovah God is the substance and center of all that is. Notice:

Ps. 107: 1-7. Halleluiah! He is the Great God. Praise His name He leads His people:

- Deut. 32: 10 He leads like a Savior, out of the desert of sin.
- Jn. 16: 13 He leads like a teacher, into the knowledge of self and God.
- Deut. 32: 11-12 He leads like an Eagle, above the things of earth.
- Ps. 23: 2-3 He leads like a Shepherd, into pastures of greenness and paths that are right.
- Isa. 58: 11 He leads like a Guide, who is faithful to the end.
- Deut. 1: 31 He leads like a Father, dealing with a weary child.

Ps. 147: 1-6. Praise Him for His wonderful works of grace:

1. He numbers the stars.
2. He calls each star by its name.
3. He gathers the outcasts.
4. He heals the broken – hearted.
5. He binds or bandages up their wounds.
6. He lifts up the meek.
7. He casts down the wicked.
